

To install the depth stop, simply slide it over the blade shaft. The depth stop may be rotated to any desired position to offer the best access while not blocking visibility for any given operation.




Figure 1: Installing the depth stop.

### Setting the Depth Stop

**!** *Caution: Blade is sharp; careless handling can result in serious injury.*

With the blade set to the desired depth of the final cut, slide the depth stop down until it contacts the body, and then tighten the knob.




Figure 2: Setting depth stop.

**...** *Tip: When installing hardware, it is best to set the blade depth, not with a measurement, but by using the actual hardware (see Figure 2).*

Raise the blade up to its starting position. Advance the blade ever so slightly with each successive cut until the depth stop contacts the body.
