Installing BS-345C-BTA BLADE TENSIONER ASSEMBLY

Suits: Bandsaw BS-345C (incl CTJ-3501)

Tools required: 2x 6mm short Allen keys

**Please note:** This procedure should be read in conjunction with the corresponding product User Manual.

- 1. **WARNING!** Turn off and unplug bandsaw from wall socket or power source
- 2. Release blade tension quick release (Fig.1), Remove table insert, remove table pin and remove bandsaw blade from saw (Fig.2)
- 3. Remove manual blade tension knob by lifting up (Fig.3)
- 4. Using 2x 6mm Allen keys, loosen upper and lower retainers (Fig.4 behind top wheel). Remove screw from one side only, and remove assemblies,. (Figs.5 & 6)
- Tilt wheel towards user and remove. This will contain wheel and wheel mounting bracket (Note for re-installation - bracket pivoting hole is towards top) (Fig.7)
- 6. Remove the blade tension assembly (Fig.8).
- 7. Reverse these steps for reinstallation.

**Please note:** Inserting upper and lower retainers may require some patience. A short Philips head screwdriver may help align the components and allow the retainers to be re-inserted..






